## Application For Open Burn Permit For Landscape Debris Only Not Leaves or Grass Clippings

**In accordance with 8-10-2 of the Village of Kildeer Municipal Code I attest that the following requirements will be followed.** No permit will be issued unless lines A thru G are initialed indicating that the permit requirements are understood.

- A. \_\_\_\_\_ My property is one acre or more in size.
- B. \_\_\_\_\_ I will only burn landscape debris, NOT leaves or grass clippings.
- C. \_\_\_\_\_ I will only conduct this burn April 15<sup>th</sup> thru May 30<sup>th</sup> or October 15<sup>th</sup> thru November 30<sup>th</sup> from 7 a.m. to dusk.
- D. \_\_\_\_\_ Open burning shall be constantly attended by an adult of eighteen years (18) of age or older, until the fire is extinguished.
- E. \_\_\_\_\_ A fire extinguisher, water supply, or other extinguishing material is available nearby during the burn.
- F. \_\_\_\_\_ Open burning shall NOT be permitted less than fifty feet (50') from any structure or overhang, (including houses, sheds, trees, power lines, trellises, balcony or deck) except for open flame cooking devices.
- G. \_\_\_\_\_ Burning is PROHIBITED when wind speed exceeds twenty (20) miles per hour and **I will contact the appropriate fire protection district one hour before the burn to verify wind speed:**
